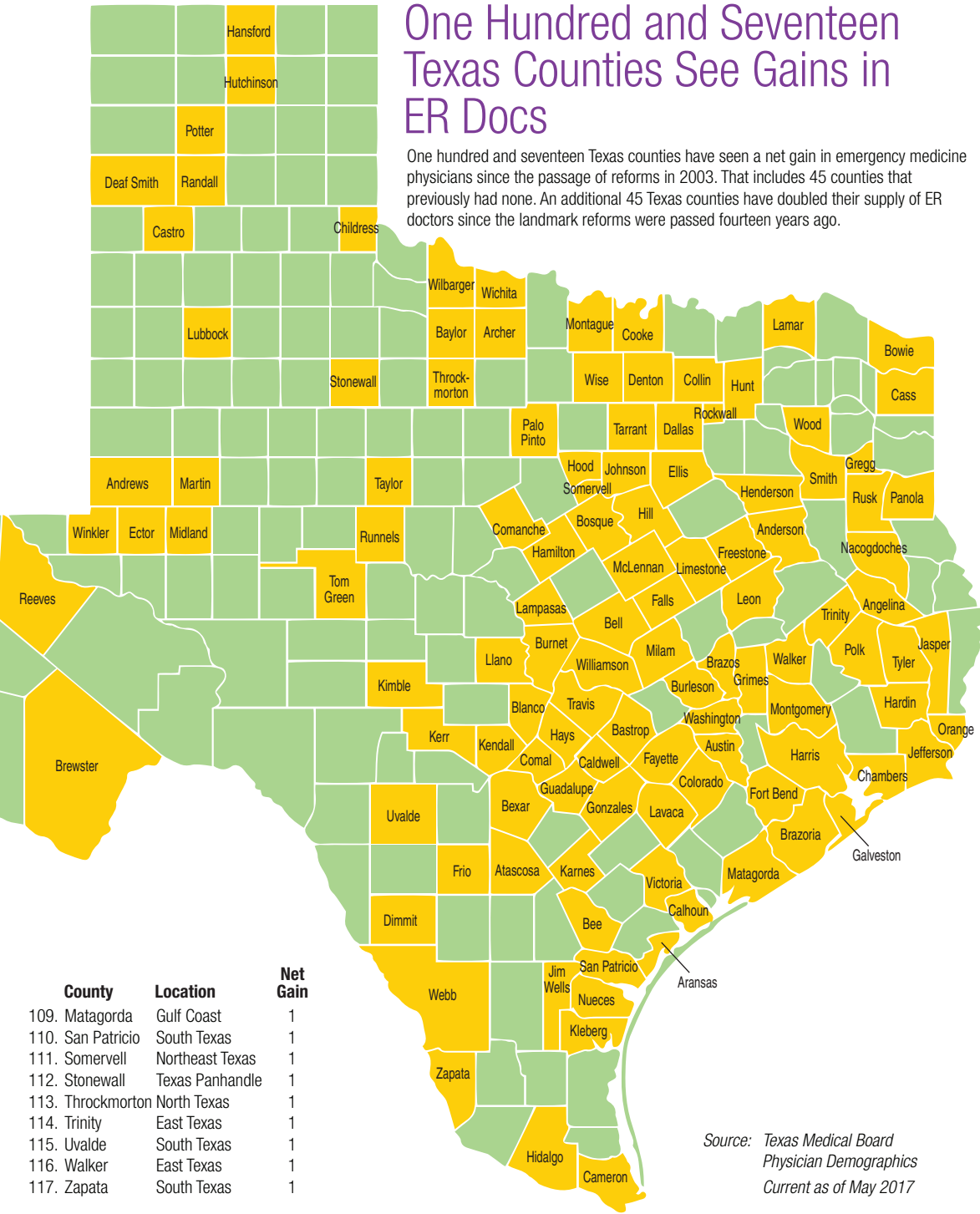

# One Hundred and Seventeen Texas Counties See Gains in ER Docs

One hundred and seventeen Texas counties have seen a net gain in emergency medicine physicians since the passage of reforms in 2003. That includes 45 counties that previously had none. An additional 45 Texas counties have doubled their supply of ER doctors since the landmark reforms were passed fourteen years ago.
