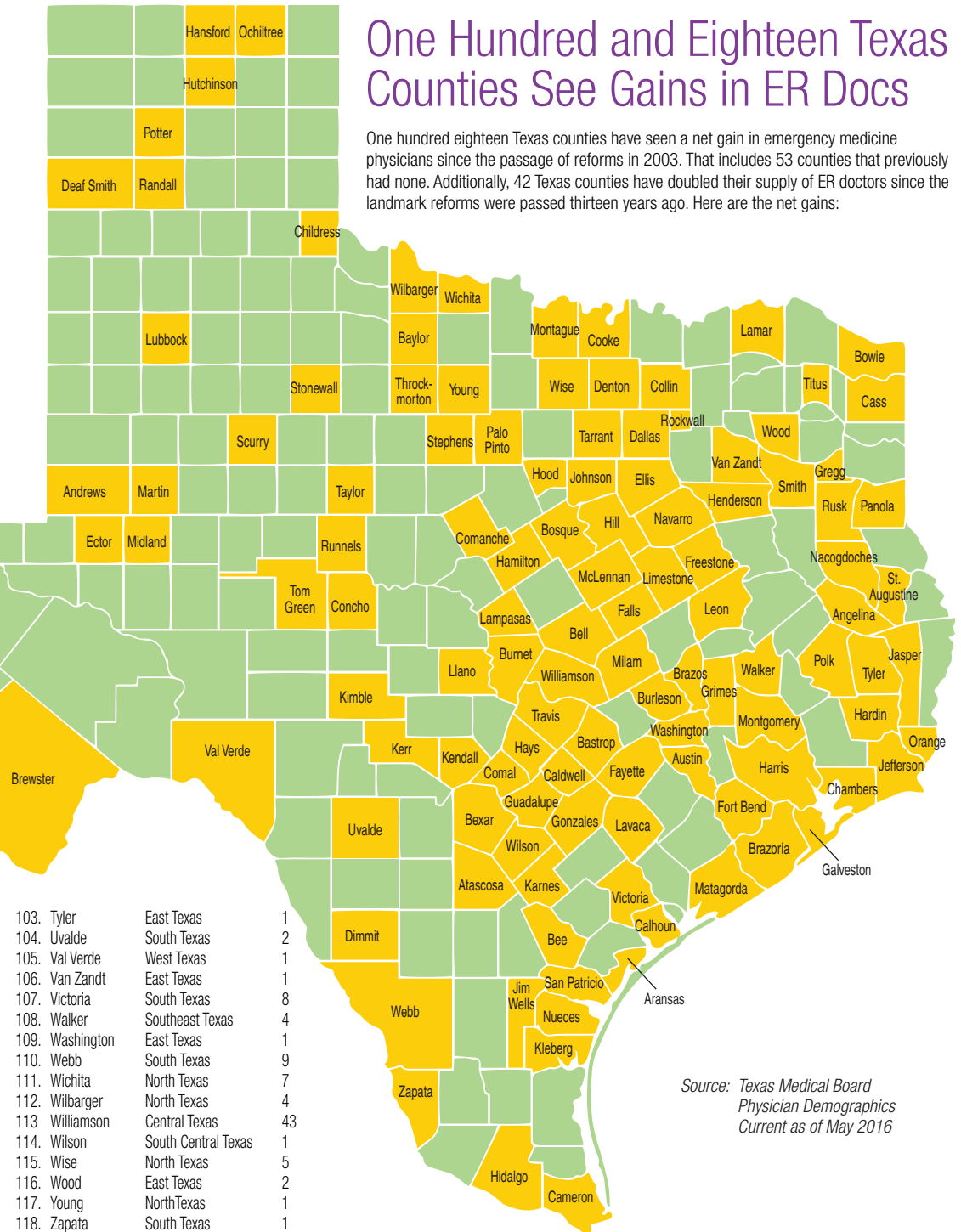

# One Hundred and Eighteen Texas Counties See Gains in ER Docs

One hundred eighteen Texas counties have seen a net gain in emergency medicine physicians since the passage of reforms in 2003. That includes 53 counties that previously had none. Additionally, 42 Texas counties have doubled their supply of ER doctors since the landmark reforms were passed thirteen years ago. Here are the net gains:
