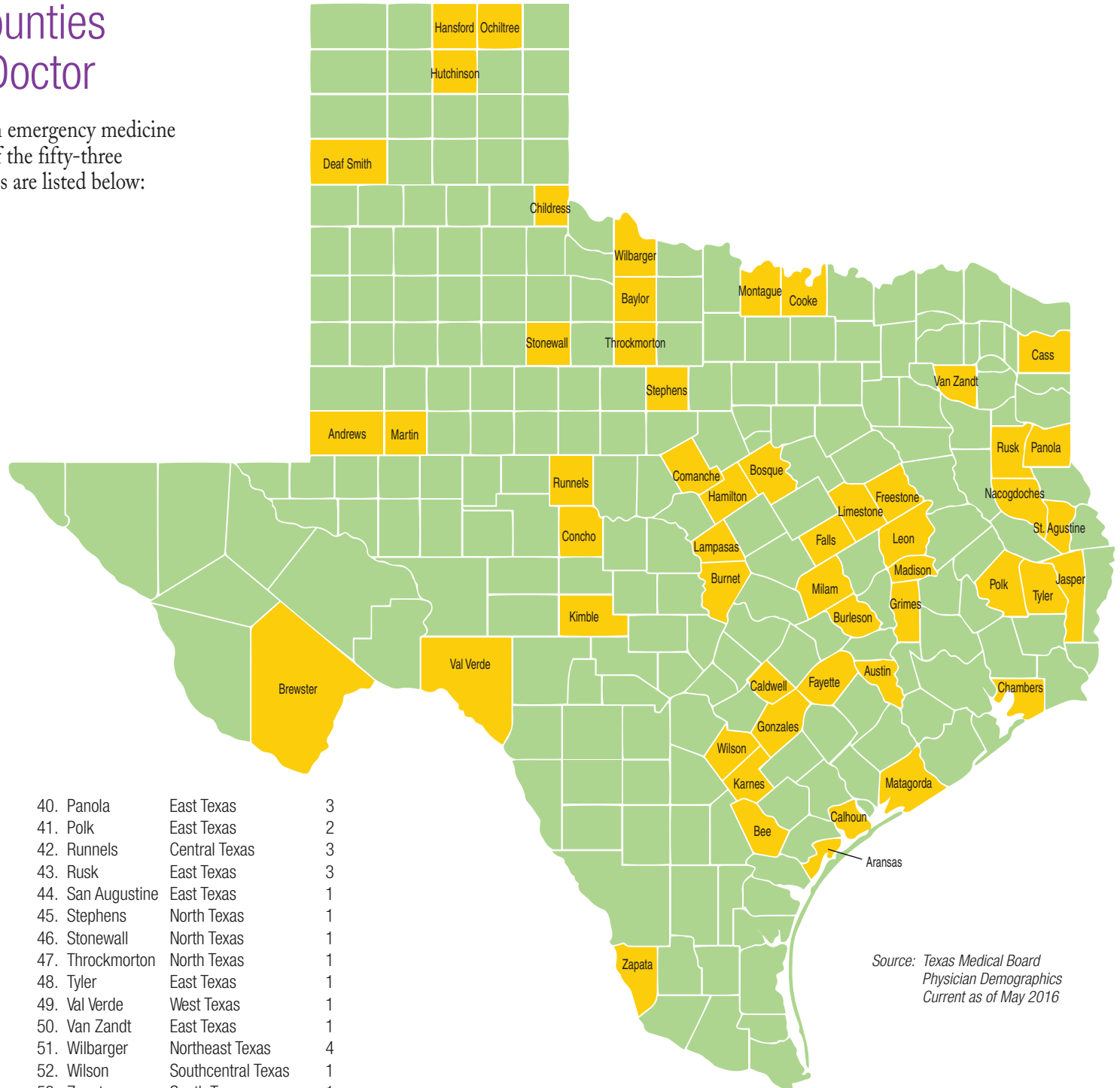


# Fifty-three Texas Counties Add Their First ER Doctor
