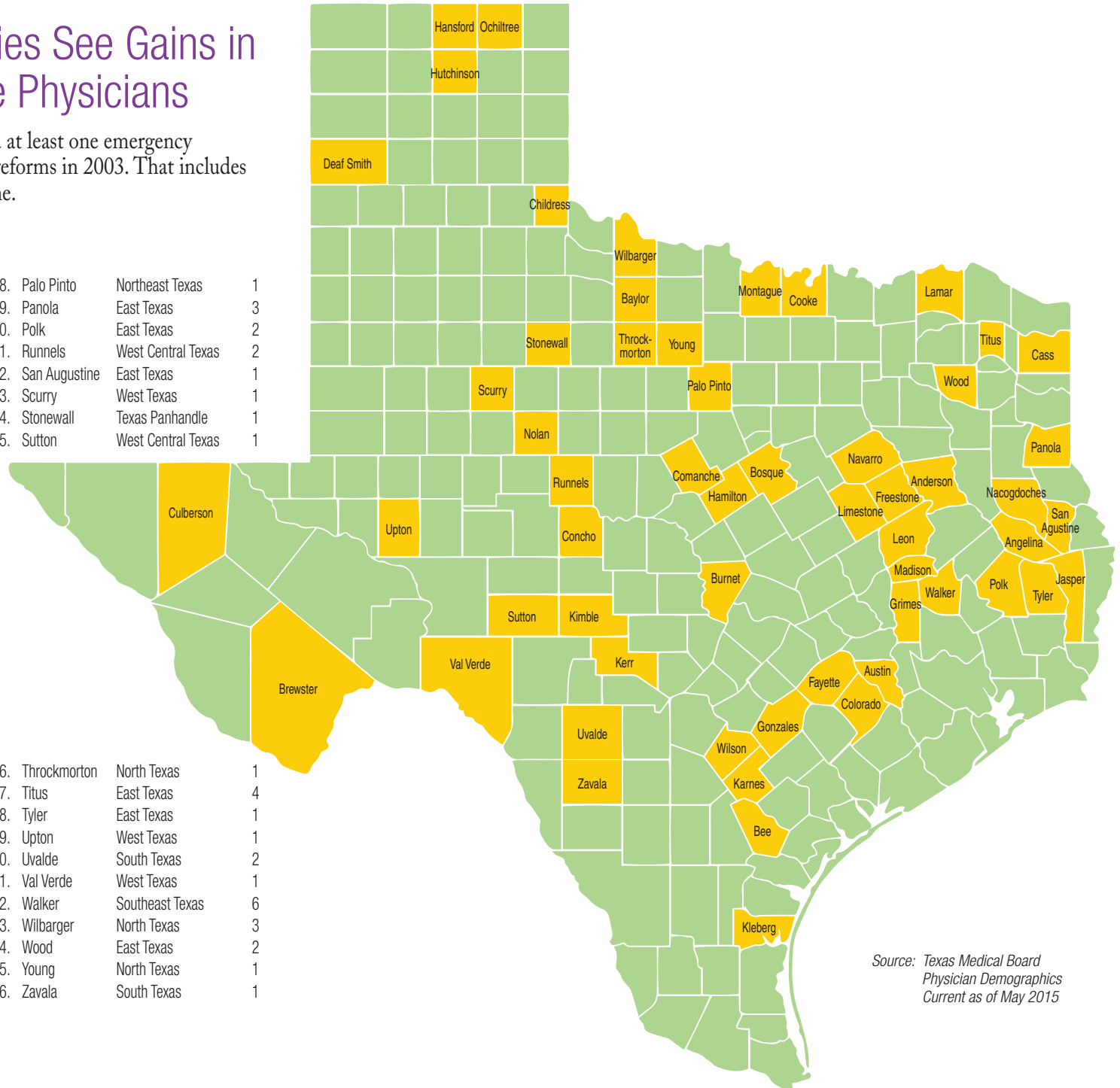


# Fifty-six Rural Counties See Gains in Emergency Medicine Physicians
